## **Diapers Help Ease Suffering in Flood**

Houston flood victims to receive relief from San Antonio based Texas Diaper Bank.

San Antonio, TEXAS – In the midst of crisis, hope is on the way for flood victims with children in Houston, via the form of diapers. Mobilizing from San Antonio, the Texas Diaper Bank is providing disaster aid to families with children by providing 20,000 diapers to the Houston Area Catholic Charities and the National Association of Christian Churches' Disaster Relief Team. The Texas Diaper Bank is able to provide these essential health items thanks to donations made from Zachry Group and its Houston area employees.

After record-breaking floods crippled the region in April, leaving 12 to 18 inches of water behind and displacing more than 1,300 individuals, the Texas Diaper Bank sought out resources to support the victims of the flooding. Zachry Group, stepped up to help fill in the diaper gap.

As one of the fastest growing nonprofits in Texas, the Texas Diaper Bank's mission is to provide services and resources to those families in crisis, currently serving 12,000 people in Bexar County and eight surrounding counties.
